Parents and Students Requesting Homebound:

The Sevier County Board of Education provides homebound to students who are deemed too medically fragile to attend school. Special dispensation is also made for students who are pregnant (see attached form). In the event of a medical emergency in which a child will be out of school for up to four weeks, homebound services will be provided upon approval of the request. Parents must pick up a homebound packet at the Sevier County Board of Education's homebound office located at the Special Education Department, 320 Cedar Street, Sevierville, 37862 or call (865) 453-1036 or 1037. The department's Homebound Coordinator, Ms. Marla Whaley, will be glad to answer questions or assist you in any way possible.

For students with serious medical issues requesting homebound services, a licensed physician must complete the medical portion, including a detailed explanation of the medical diagnosis and the need for homebound. Each homebound application is for a six-week period and must be resubmitted at the end of that period for an extension.

Students who are seeking homebound services for emotional or psychological disorders, such as bipolar disorder, depression, anxiety or phobias, must have the form completed by a licensed clinical psychologist, neurologist or psychiatrist. Family physicians not licensed in treating psychological disorders may not be the doctor of record in these cases.
